



Covid Protocols

In order to comply with Government Guidelines and Steventon Village Hall Conditions of hire the following precautions will be in place unless guidance changes.

Rehearsals will be from 7:45pm to 9:15pm – for the time being.

Please do not arrive or enter the hall before 7:30pm – only the set-up team will be inside the hall before 7:30

On entering the hall we ask you to wear a mask and if you have to queue please keep two metres apart from other members. A committee member will check you in and keep a register

Sanitize your hands with the sanitizer provided and collect any music from the librarian before taking your seat.

Seats will be allocated, spaced apart and should not be moved. Once you have taken your seat then you may remove your mask

You must not attend if you or anyone in your household has had Covid symptoms in the last seven days

If you are running a temperature

If you are feeling unwell in any way

If you develop Covid within 7 days of attending a rehearsal you must notify Caroline or Helen

We will not be serving refreshments of any kind. Please bring your own drink with you and take any rubbish away with you

In order to comply with government guidance doors and windows will be opened to ensure good ventilation. Therefore, please ensure you have warm clothing with you should you require an extra layer

One way of checking whether you are likely to be infectious with Covid is to do a NHS Rapid Lateral Flow Test on the day in question. These can be obtained on line through <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests> or they are available for free at any chemist.

Whilst we cannot enforce this practice we strongly encourage members to do this to ensure the safety of everyone attending.
